NEITI SOUTH-EAST ROAD SHOW IN ENUGU

President Olusegun Obasanjo GCFR inaugurated a Nigerian Extractive Industries Transparency Initiative Working Group (NSWG) in February 2004.

This was in response to the poor public (local and international) perception of systems and procedures for the generation, allocation, accounting and management of revenues derived from minerals extraction.

The NSWG seeks to address this situation through measures that can improve the capacity of Civil Society Organizations to constructively engage Governments at all levels (Federal, State and Local) in the demand for accountability as well as ask the right questions of the Extractive Industries.

A two-day workshop (Road Show) is therefore planned for the 17th and 18th of August 2006 at the Protea Hotel, Nike Lake Enugu.
